Winemaking Notes

The 2018 year saw significant increase in total tonnage grown in Washington, a 14% increase, and was the second largest in Washington State history (just behind 2016). A Fairly warm spring was followed by a very warm summer, but temperatures cooled considerably in September, creating a long harvest season and ideal conditions for ripening. Bud break in 2018 was slightly late. Brix accumulation was excellent due to warm harvest days; but September nights were cool, providing higher than average acidity, great for white wines this year.

Tasting Notes

The 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon has a defined dark fruit and violet aroma on the nose. You'll find a delicious blend of black raspberry, anise and eucalyptus on the palate, followed by a saddle leather sense on the finish.
