Winemaking Notes

2021 was a warm growing season in Washington marked by a record shattering heat event in late June. Bud break began in the Columbia Valley at the very beginning of April, ahead of historical averages. The weather at bloom, which began in the third week of May, was somewhat unsettled, with hot, dry winds. A heat dome descended upon the west coast and shattered all previous temperature records in every location at the end of June. Temperatures cooled down in September and October, allowing for extended hang time for those who sought it. While the crop was much smaller than growers and winemakers would have liked, all were pleased with quality. Brix were somewhat elevated, and many reported that acids held on surprisingly well considering the warmth of the year.

The 2021 Awesome is bold with flavors of black cherry, cocoa, clove and eucalyptus with a hint of cedar and a splash of Awesome!
